



SSE announce intent to demolish plant on Slough Trading Estate

10 October 2018

SSE has today announced Keltbray as its Principal Contractor for the demolition of part of the Slough Heat and Power Plant on the Slough Trading Estate.

Planning permission to construct a Multifuel facility at the site was granted in 2015 and construction of the new Multifuel facility, which will have a generating capacity of up to 50MW, is expected to commence following demolition activities at the site.

Decommissioning of specific areas and associated plant are required to facilitate the new Multifuel development and this is underway in preparation for demolition. The remaining part of the Slough Heat and Power plant currently supplies energy, water and heat to its customers on the trading estate and this will not be affected by the demolition works.

Keltbray are a UK leading specialist contractor, which has a wealth of experience in complex demolition and decommissioning works.
